End-of-Support of First-Generation CP-HW-500

Aruba, a Hewlett Packard Enterprise company is announcing End-of-Support for the first-generation of the CP-HW-500 appliances. The first-generation CP-HW-500 appliances included 4GB of memory and can no longer support the latest version of ClearPass, version 6.7. The End of Support date for the first-generation appliances is April 6, 2019 to coincide with the End-of-Life of ClearPass 6.6. Customers with first-generation appliances will no longer be able to renew support contracts after April 6 2018 to coincide with the End of Development of ClearPass 6.6.

The first-generation CP-HW-500 appliance was replaced with a different hardware platform on September 1, 2015. The first-generation appliance has 'ClearPass – CP500' on its faceplate.



It can also be identified by the amount of memory installed as shown below.
