Notification

Intel Active Management Technology, Intel Small Business Technology, and Intel Standard Manageability Escalation of Privilege

INTEL-SA-00075, CVE-2017-5689 published by Intel on May 1, 2017

Summary:

There is an escalation of privilege vulnerability in Intel® Active Management Technology (AMT), Intel® Standard Manageability (ISM), and Intel® Small Business Technology versions firmware versions 6.x, 7.x, 8.x 9.x, 10.x, 11.0, 11.5, and 11.6 that can allow an unprivileged attacker to gain control of the manageability features provided by these products.

We carefully reviewed all Silver Peak products. AMT, SBT, ISM are not enabled in all platforms except for one. In that one platform, AMT is enabled, but is not accessible locally or remotely as described in Intel's Mitigation guide -

This vulnerability does not affect Silver Peak appliances including EdgeConnect and NX. It is not applicable to virtual appliances EdgeConnect-V, VX, and Silver Peak Unity Orchestrator/GMS.
